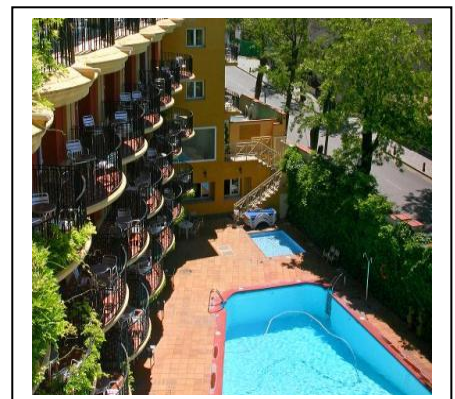


Granada in the south of Spain - a city of contrasts and surprises; it is a city that seduces the senses and where the old seamlessly blends with the new. Sunny, flower-filled plazas lined with tapas bars contrast with palm trees and exotic Moroccan teashops straight from the Arabian nights.

With this as our backdrop, we will visit **7 very different gardens** and discover the curious and delightful stories behind the secret *carmens* (enclosed gardens), learn about the fascinating history of the Alhambra Palace and Generalife Garden, hear interesting tales of life in the times of the Sultans and explore the historic centre.

Throughout the 3 days, we will be accompanied by our **official guide, Nicholas Borjesson**, who has provided tours for the **Royal Danish Garden Society** and was the **guide** for Michelle Obama when she visited Granada in 2010. We will also have the benefit of Spain's most prolific expat **gardening author and speaker, Dick Handscombe**, for an after dinner talk. He will be on hand to share his wide practical experience and observations as well as chairing a **Gardener's Question & Answer** session.

Accommodation is in the beautiful, 4 star **Hotel Los Angeles**, which has a spa and swimming pool, as well as balconies with amazing views of the Sierra Nevada mountains – and all only 10 minutes walk from the centre of town. **Optional extras** include a tapas tour (Granada is famous for these little snacks that accompany drinks), a flamenco show, Arab baths with massage, a walking tour and an accompanied shopping trip.
